

Toogoodoo Creek Raft-up and Picnic Saturday, 6 September 2014

The Squadron's September Cruise is a raft-up and onboard picnic in Toogoodoo Creek near Wadmalaw Island, SC. Toogoodoo Creek is one of the most beautiful unspoiled waterways in South Carolina. So, you won't want to miss this very scenic cruise. We are planning an on board bring-some-stuff-to-share" pot luck picnic. So, plan to go boat-to-boat "grazing" and sampling whatever food is offered.

To get to Toogoodoo Creek, take the ICW from Charleston south past the Limehouse Bridge Landing at Johns Island and follow the ICW for another 15 miles to Red Marker R102 near Bluff Point on Wadmalaw Island. Continue 0.5 miles past Marker R102. The entrance for Toogoodoo Creek will be to starboard. Enter Toogoodoo Creek and continue 2.5 miles to our raft-up location at GPS 32 40.160 North/080 17.436 West. See the attached chart section.

Captain Joe Ewalt will skipper the Squadron's lead boat for this cruise. He plans to leave Limehouse Landing around 10:30 AM and proceed to the raft-up.
